Housing Matters Tenancy Support Service

Who is the service for?

Housing Matters (Tenancy Support) is for people, over the age of 18 and living in the County of Leicestershire. The support service can work with people in any of the following circumstances:

- A person who may need help to move into and set up their new home
- A person who is currently in temporary accommodation waiting for permanent housing
- A person who already has their own home but is at risk of becoming homeless

The service can work with people regardless of whether they live in a council tenancy, a housing association tenancy, a private tenancy or even those who own their own home.

What does the service provide?

We will provide you with a dedicated Housing Support Worker to help you with managing your housing situation. Support will be focused on helping you to achieve security and independence in your home; our Housing Support Workers will complete a support plan and agree the support they can offer you. We will keep in touch with you through home visits, phone contact, digital channels, drop in's and group work.

How to access Housing Matters?

You can be referred to us by your local council housing options/needs service or another professional you are working with. We also accept self referrals. For short term support you can access our Drop In's across the county.

Housing Matters Accommodation Service

What does the service provide?

The Falcon Centre provides quick access emergency accommodation. We are based in Loughborough town centre, within easy access of good transport links, with strong community, connections and close to local amenities. Our facilities consist of an ensuite bedroom and communal lounge/dining area with catered breakfast and evening meal. A personal charge is payable to cover the cost of food, light, heating and water.

Accommodation is based on a short term stay of 10 months. We have a dedicated staff team on site 24/7, with a Support Worker assigned to each individual to provide regular high quality person centred support. We help you identify and review your needs to create a tailor made Support and Action Plan so you can develop the skills necessary to gain permanent accommodation.

Who is this service for?

Housing Matters (Supported
Accommodation) is for single people, over
the age of 18, who are homeless or at risk of
homelessness with a local connection to
Leicestershire. Accommodation is offered
with a Licence Agreement and Support
Agreement.


We are a dog friendly service so can accommodate one dog at a time.
